Larry may be wondering what "collected images are"

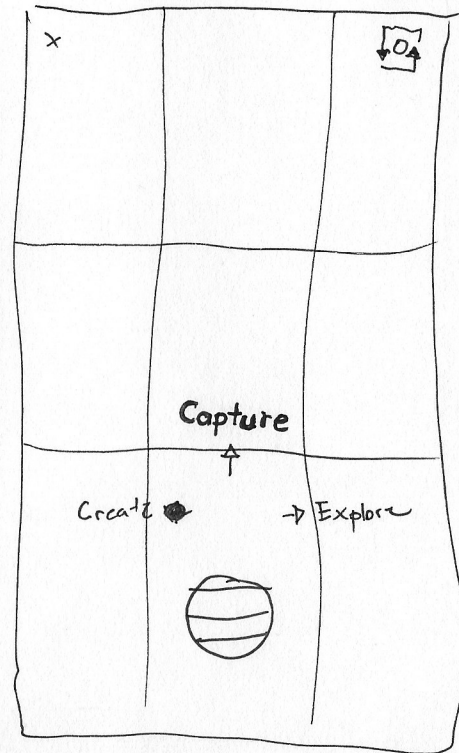
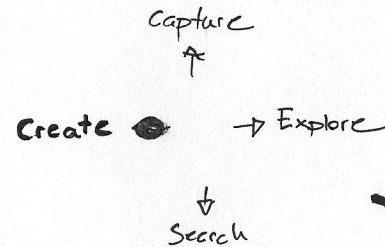

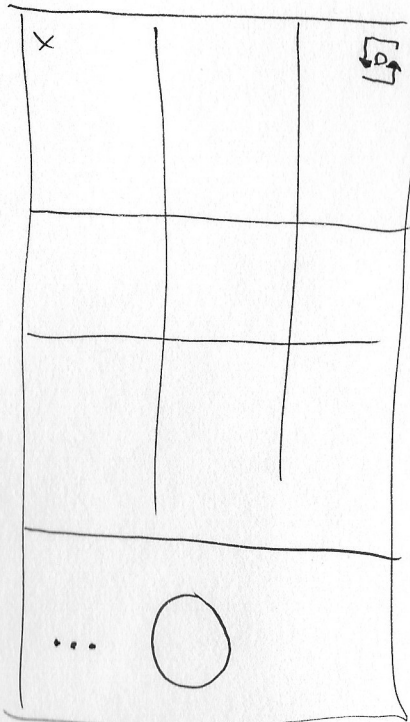

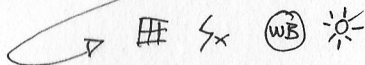


Larry will need to swip up in order to capture a photo

He will need to click

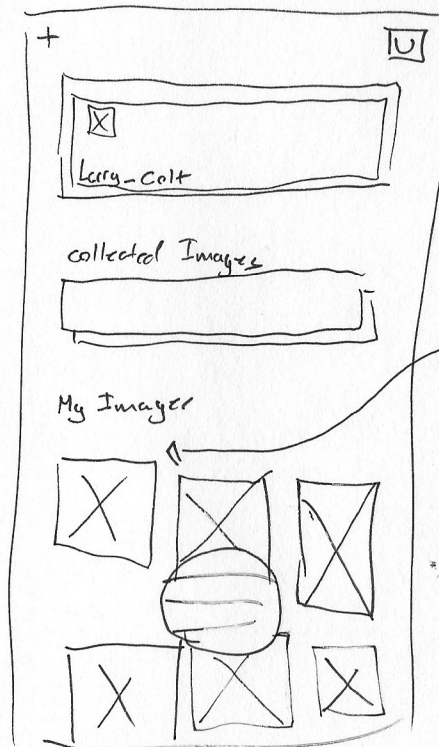
the circle at the

When Lorry clicks the X he will be taken to the home screen

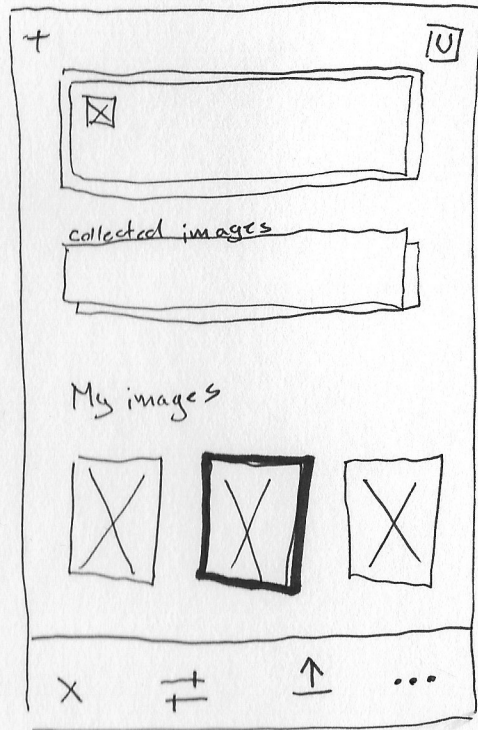

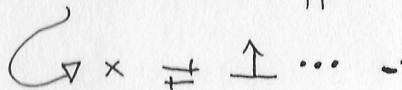

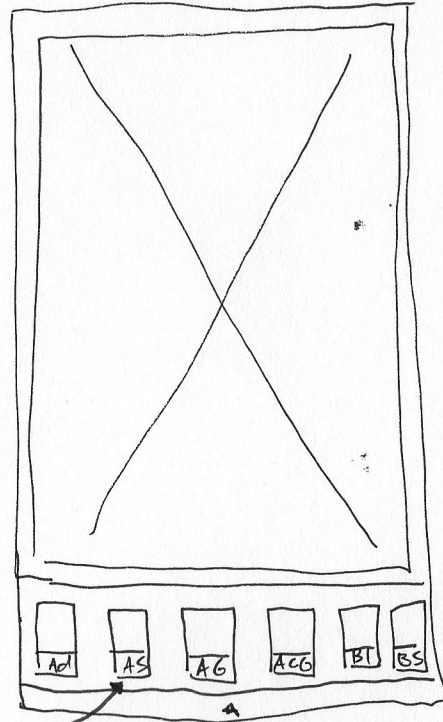
- ② - When I use the app

Larry needs to select \pm to edit the selected photo.

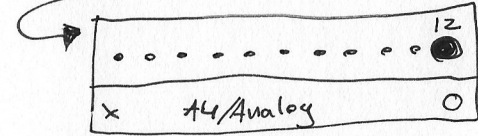


Larry can choose from one of these filters.

When he selects a filter the photo shows the change

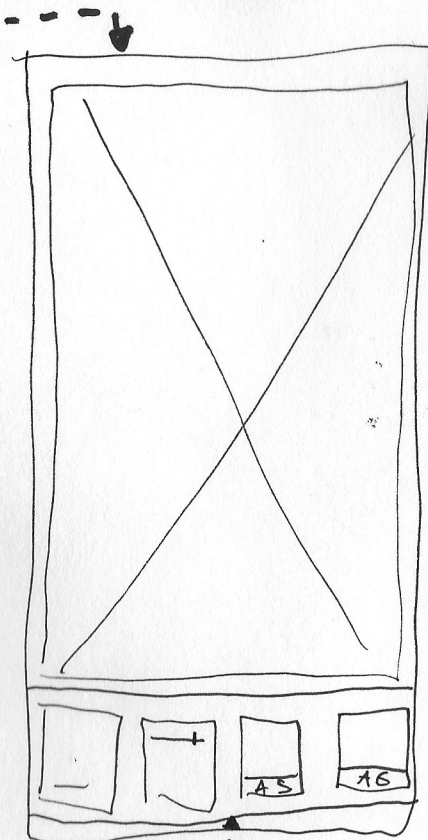
If Larry double taps the filter he is presented with this adjustment bar at the bottom

[there may be some confusion of what to do next. There are no prompts here]

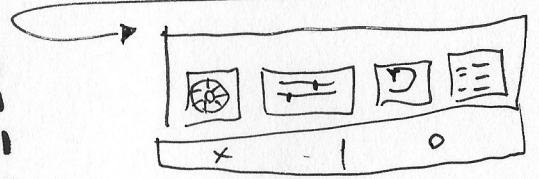
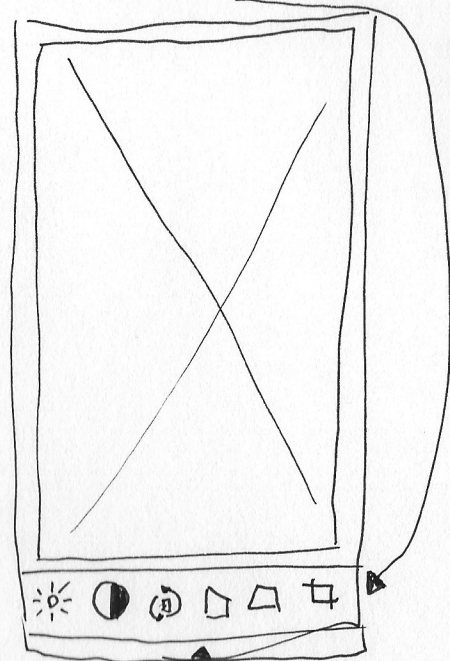


Larry will need to click  in order to make adjustments to the photo

After Larry makes all the ~~adjustment~~ edits he wants he needs to select the icon again to bring up this




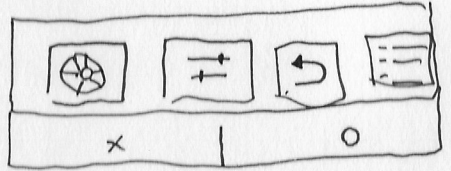
Larry will now need to select click here

Selecting  will keep all the edits and Larry will be prompted to publish to my profile

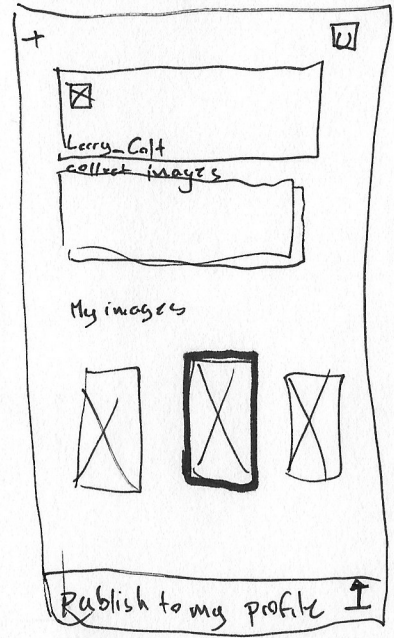
When he does that this menu appears

Larry needs to tap  to publish the photo. If he doesn't then the option will go away



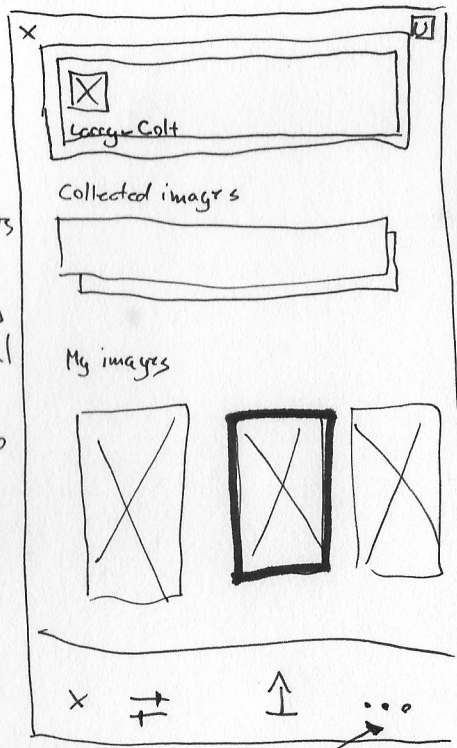
When each icon is selected a different adjustment bars appear

If Larry wants to share his photo using other social media he will need to ~~click~~ tap here

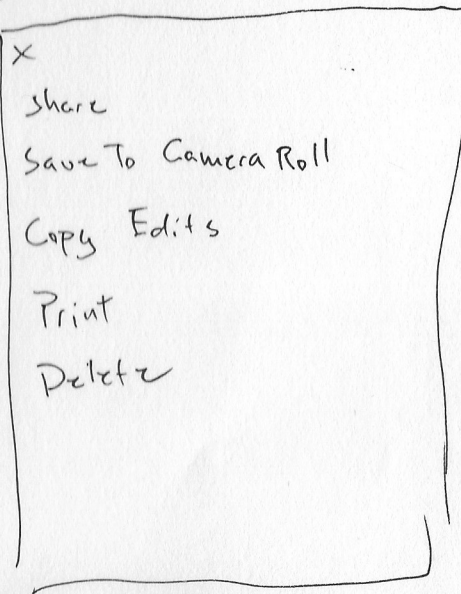


When Larry taps share another menu will appear showing several Social Media options.

Larry can choose one and post it to that site

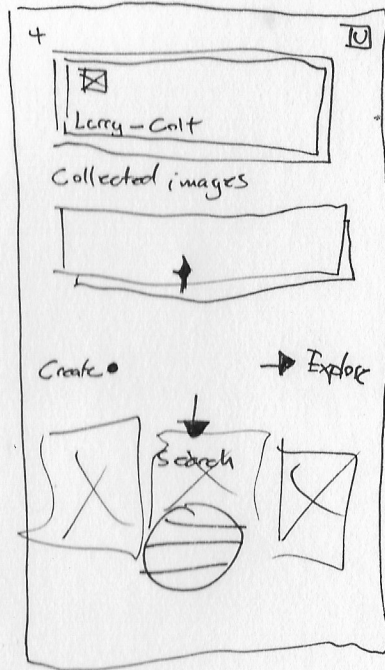
The share button is hidden deeper in the app. Larry may not like he has to go searching for this function.

- So I can see the photos they are publishing



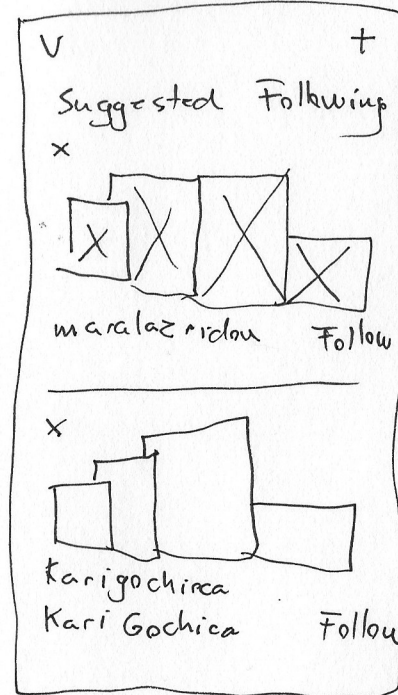
Larry will need to tap and hold  then swip right to explore
